- Full-size movie screen with digital projector



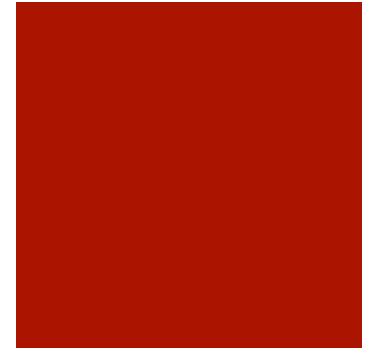

- Food prep area with serving window to main hall and patio



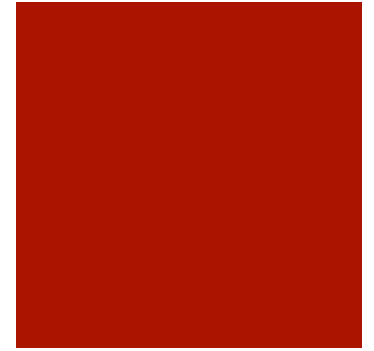
Extended Space
